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TIDESWELL FOOD FESTIVAL TRADER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Stalls must be manned by a competent person at all times.
2. All stallholders must comply with current Trading Standards and Environmental Health requirements.
3. No stallholder will dismantle his display, or vacate the stall before 4pm
- 4.. Any stallholder displaying unwrapped produce and/or providing food samples must possess a flask of hot water, bowl, soap and a towel for hand cleansing purposes. All produce should be clearly labelled with the producer's name and address along with written information about the produce.
5. Stallholders shall possess current public, employee and product liability insurance with cover of at least £1 million. (* I understand that if this runs out before the event, or I do not forward this information at this stage, I am responsible to provide this no later than one calendar month before the event, and that without this, I will not be able to take part in the festival and will lose my non refundable payment.) .
6. If you wish to use electricity (own generator) a valid PAT test Certificate must be held, and all electrical items must have a valid PAT test sticker attached. All cables must have a circuit breaker at the socket.
- 7 Traders selling alcohol products must apply for a TENS license.
8. Stalls must be set up by 9.30 am in time for the event to open at 10.00 am.
9. Vehicles may be unloaded in the adjacent to the stall, but afterwards must be moved into the car parking area reserved for traders.
10. The allocation of stalls is solely the responsibility of the event organiser. Stallholders must accept the location of the stall allocated to them and no encroachment of position will be allowed.
11. Stallholders shall maintain their stall spaces in a clean and sanitary condition and remove all boxes, packaging and debris throughout the day and take all rubbish away with them at the end of the event.
12. Stallholders shall ensure that at all times the goods are displayed in such a manner as to allow the unobstructed movement of the public.
13. Stall fees must be fully paid in advance. Cancellation is not allowed and stall fees are not refundable.
14. There is a No Smoking regulation for those selling foodstuffs
